**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 260-2003**

**To amend Municipal Code Chapter 841, Waste Collection, Commercial Properties, to  
provide for an earlier set out time for certain commercial properties.**

WHEREAS certain provisions in Municipal Code Chapter 844, Waste Collection, Residential Properties, require amendment to provide for an earlier set out time for commercial properties which close prior to 8:00 p.m.;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto Municipal Code § 844-12 is amended as follows:
  - (1) By adding the following as subsection E:
    - E. Despite subsections A1 and B1, the owner of a commercial property which closes for business prior to 8:00 p.m. shall set out garbage, recyclable materials and organic materials at the collection point no earlier than the time at which the commercial property closes for business provided that the Owner shall not, under any circumstance, set out garbage, recyclable materials and organic materials at the collection point prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day before collection if the owner receives services during a daytime collection period or prior to 6:00 p.m. on the first day of a nighttime collection period if the owner receives services during a nighttime collection period.
  - (2) By deleting, in Subsection C, the phrase "A and B" and substituting "A, B and E".
2. The following By-laws shall continue to be in effect, provided that in the event of a conflict between Chapter 841 and a by-law referred to below, Chapter 841 shall prevail.
  - A. Toronto, Chapter 309, as amended.
  - B. Etobicoke, Chapter 149, as amended.
  - C. East York, By-law No. 1-86, as amended.
  - D. York, By-law No. 2890-78, as amended.
  - E. Scarborough, By-law No. 24478, as amended.
  - F. North York, By-law No. 21732, as amended.
