CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 299-2003

To appoint a Fire Chief.

WHEREAS, in accordance with sections 18 and 19 of the *City of Toronto Act, 1997*, the Council of the City of Toronto (the "Council") was deemed to have taken all steps required to appoint Alan Speed to the office of Fire Chief for the City of Toronto (the "City"); and

WHEREAS Chief Speed retires from the City effective April 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS subsection 6(1) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997* provides that, if a fire department is established for the whole or a part of a municipality or for more than one municipality, the council of the municipality or the councils of the municipalities, as the case may be, shall appoint a fire chief for the fire department; and

WHEREAS Council is desirous of appointing William A. Stewart as the Fire Chief for the City;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Subject to section 2, William A. Stewart is appointed Fire Chief effective May 1, 2003.
- 2. This by-law comes into force on May 1, 2003, if William A. Stewart has entered into an employment contract with the City on or before April 30, 2003.
- 3. Upon his appointment as Fire Chief pursuant to section 1, William A. Stewart shall have, in addition to any other powers and duties imposed upon the Fire Chief by any statute or by any other by-law of the City, all the powers and duties imposed upon the Fire Chief by Chapter 79 of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
- **4.** On the date this by-law comes into force, By-law No. 6-1998 is repealed.
