## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 304-2003

To amend former City of North York By-law No. 7625 and By-law No. 22135 in respect of lands municipally known as 160 Chalkfarm Drive.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 22135 is amended by deleting Section 2(h) and adding the following subsections:
  - "(h) a tuck shop with maximum gross floor area of 132 m² is permitted in the ground floor of Building 4 as shown on Schedule "A";
    - (i) that all other provisions of By-law No. 7625, as amended, are complied with".
