FIRSTLY: Part of PIN 10084-0161 (LT).

Part of Lot 269 on Plan M-372 designated as PART 2 on Plan 66R-18861.

The southerly limit of Spring Garden Avenue as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-538 (Plan D221, Instrument A435865).

SECONDLY: Part of PIN 10084-0163 (LT).

Part of Lot 270 on Plan M-372 designated as PART 4 on Plan 66R-18861.

The southerly limit of Spring Garden Avenue as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-538 (Plan D221, Instrument A435865).

THIRDLY: PIN 10084-0165 (LT).

Part of Lot 271 on Plan M-372 designated as PART 5 on Plan 66R-18861.

The southerly limit of Spring Garden Avenue as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-538 (Plan D221, Instrument A435865) is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Spring Garden Avenue.
