## BY-LAW No. 312-2003

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane north of Clarence Square extending easterly from Spadina Avenue.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the Commissioner of Urban Planning and Development Services' Statement of Approval/Undertaking No. U399042 respecting 55 Spadina Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane north of Clarence Square extending easterly from Spadina Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Parts of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 on Plan D-293 designated as PART 2 on Plan 64R-16846 in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66).

The easterly limit of Spadina Avenue as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-1247 (CT293797) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
