CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 320-2003

To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

ONE-WAY STREETS - SCHEDULE XII

1. That Schedule XII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Direction</u>
Gilbert Avenue	A point 38 metres south of Eglinton Avenue West and a point 43 metres south thereof	Anytime	Southbound
