CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 328-2003

To amend By-law No. 196-84 of the former City of York, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

ENTRY PROHIBITED - SCHEDULE XVII

1. That Schedule XVII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Prohibited Times or Days</u>
Robina Avenue	A point 67.1 metres north of St. Clair Avenue West	Anytime, except TTC vehicles

ENTRY PROHIBITED - SCHEDULE XVII

2. That Schedule XVII of former City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Prohibited Times or Days</u>
Robina Avenue	A point 102 metres north of St. Clair Avenue West	Anytime
