## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 329-2003**

#### **To amend further By-law No. 20-96, a by-law “To provide for the overnight parking on Borough streets”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

WHEREAS in order to provide for permit parking on a 24 hour basis, 7 days a week, it is necessary to create a new Schedule “F” of the former Borough of East York By-law No. 20-96;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 20-96, entitled “To provide for the overnight permit parking on Borough streets”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is amended as follows:
  - A. By replacing the words “or Schedule “E”” in Sections 1.10, 3.1, 3.3, 3.5, 4.1, 5.3, 5.6, 5.10(ii), and 8.11 with the words “Schedule “E”, or Schedule “F””.
  - B. By replacing the words “and “E”” in Section 3.1 and 8.8 with the words “ “E”and “F”.
  - C. By adding a new Section 5.11 as follows:

“5.11 A Permit for Parking on a street set out in Column 1 of Schedule “F” shall entitle the Owner to Park the Motor Vehicle for which it was issued to park continuously during any 24 hour period on the designated street”.
  - D. By adding a new Schedule “F” in the following form:

E. By inserting in Schedule “F” the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Moore Avenue	South	Moore Avenue - from a point 33 metres west of Bayview Avenue to a point 104.5 metres west thereof	19	24 hours	Moore Avenue only
