BY-LAW No. 345-2003

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Gilmour Avenue and Maher Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule I (One-Way Highways) in § 400-54, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Gilmour Avenue (west, south and east sides of traffic island/circle)	Maher Avenue and Maher Avenue	Anytime	From west to east (counterclockwise)
Maher Avenue (north side of traffic island/circle)	Gilmour Avenue and Gilmour Avenue	Anytime	From east to west (counterclockwise)

B. By inserting in Schedule V (Yield Intersections) in § 400-58, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Gilmour Avenue and laneway between Premises Nos. 157 and 183 Gilmour Avenue	Laneway between Premises Nos. 157 and 183 Gilmour Avenue
Gilmour Avenue and Maher Avenue	Maher Avenue (eastbound)
