BY-LAW No. 383-2003

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “White Pine Avenue and Hackberry Street” and “Woodville Avenue and Rivercourt Boulevard” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 2
Stop Streets)

On Woodmount Avenue north of Frater Avenue

On Woodmount Avenue south of Frater Avenue
