CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 404-2003

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Aberdeen Avenue, Duart Park Road, Hannaford Street, Jones Avenue, Page Street, Woodfield Road and Woodmount Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Hannaford Street	East	A point 48 metres north of Kingston Road and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Aberdeen Avenue	North	A point 54.5 metres west of Parliament Street and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Duart Park Road	South	A point 63.0 metres west of MacLean Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Jones Avenue	West	A point 9.0 metres north of Harcourt Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Page Street	South	A point 46.6 metres west of Clinton Street and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Woodfield Road	West	A point 30.0 metres south of Walpole Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

Woodmount Avenue	East	A point 20.5 metres north of Wolverleigh Boulevard and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
