BY-LAW No. 410-2003

**To layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes to form part of the public
highway Keele Street north of Nashville Avenue.**

Whereas the City is the owner of certain land located in the vicinity of 1652 Keele Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public highway Keele Street north of Nashville Avenue,
described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10498-0283 (LT).

Being parts of Lots 872, 873 and 874 on Plan 2008 designated as PART 4 on
Plan 64R-10339 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in
the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and
dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Keele Street.
