BY-LAW No. 421-2003

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form a new public lane south of Hanson Street extending westerly from Bastedo Avenue.

Whereas the City is acquiring certain lands in connection with a Consent Agreement with respect to the development of 2 Bastedo Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land south of Hanson Street extending westerly from Bastedo Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Parts of Lots 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158 and part of Bastedo Avenue closed by City of Toronto By-law No. 8960(88251T) on Plan 1409-York designated as PART 20 on Plan 64R-16169 in the Land Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes to form a new public lane south of Hanson Street extending westerly from Bastedo Avenue.

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect until the conveyance to the City of the land described in Section 1 and the necessary land registrations respecting that conveyance are completed.
