CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 475-2003

To permanently close the public lane north of Adelaide Street East, extending easterly from Ontario Street, at the rear of Premises No. 474 Adelaide Street East.

WHEREAS it is recommended that the public lane north of Adelaide Street East, extending easterly from Ontario Street, at the rear of Premises No. 474 Adelaide Street East, be permanently closed as a public lane and be sold to the abutting owner upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 46 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by Council at its Special meeting held on July 30, 31 and August 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said lane was published in a daily newspaper on May 26, 2003, and was posted on the notices page of the City's web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Toronto East York Community Council meeting held on June 10, 2003 and no one appeared to address the Toronto East York Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public lane north of Adelaide Street East, extending easterly from Ontario Street, at the rear of Premises No. 474 Adelaide Street East, described as follows:

Part of the Public Lane on Plan 454 designated as Part 1 on Plan 66R-19925 in the Land Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is hereby permanently closed as a public lane.
