CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 511-2003

To authorize the entering into of an agreement for the provision of Municipal Capital Facilities respecting the Bayview Neighbourhood Branch Library.

WHEREAS subsection 110(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 provides that the council of a municipality may enter into agreements for the provision of municipal capital facilities with any person; and

WHEREAS paragraph 11 of section 2 of Ontario Regulation 46/94, as amended, prescribes municipal facilities for public libraries as eligible municipal capital facilities; and

WHEREAS Council is desirous of entering into an agreement for the provision of municipal capital facilities with the landlord of the Bayview Village Shopping Centre at 2901 Bayview Avenue, in respect of the land to be leased by the Toronto Public Library Board for the relocation of its Bayview Neighbourhood Branch;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto is authorized to enter into an agreement under subsection 110(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 with the landlord of the Bayview Village Shopping Centre for the provision of a municipal capital facility for the Bayview Neighbourhood Branch Library with respect to the land to be leased by the Toronto Public Library Board at the Bayview Village Shopping Centre at 2901 Bayview Avenue.
