CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 518-2003

To amend former City of North York By-law No. 7625 in respect of lands municipally known as Emery Village Secondary Plan.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" of this By-law.
- **2.** Section 27 of By-law No. 7625 is amended by:
 - (i) deleting the lands and premises known municipally in June 2003 as 2350 Finch Avenue West from Schedule "1" of amending By-law No. 422-2003, as shown on Schedule "1" attached to this by-law; and,
 - (ii) revising the building heights of Schedule "C(5)" of amending By-law No. 422-2003 as shown on Schedule "C(5)" attached to this by-law, in order to permit building heights ranging from 2 to 18 storeys for lands known municipally as 15-19, 21 and 23 Toryork Drive and building heights ranging from 2 to 10 storeys for vacant lands located at the north-west corner of Toryork Drive.


