BY-LAW No. 522-2003

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Amroth Avenue, Bain Avenue, Churchill Avenue, Curzon Street, Langford
Avenue, Lawlor Avenue, Markham Street and Norwood Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Curzon Street	West	A point 63.0 metres north of Queen Street East and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Amroth Avenue	West	A point 95 metres south of Danforth Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Bain Avenue	South	A point 88.5 metres west of Logan Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Churchill Avenue	South	A point 11.0 metres west of Lakeview Avenue and a point 6.0 metres further west	Anytime
Lawlor Avenue	West	A point 49 metres south of Gerrard Street East and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime

Langford Avenue	East	A point 112 metres south of Aldwych Avenue	A point 5.5 metres further south	10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., daily
Markham Street	East	A point 140.0 metres north of Dundas Street West	A point 7.0 metres further north	Anytime
