BY-LAW No. 562-2003

To amend the Contribution Rebate By-law for the 2003 election.

WHEREAS By-law No. 1011-2002 establishes the conditions under which payment of rebates may be made to persons who make contributions to candidates in the 2003 election for an office on the municipal council; and

WHEREAS Toronto City Council has resolved to remove the condition that applicants for a rebate must reside in the City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The words “residing in the City of Toronto” are removed from sections 1 and 2 of City of Toronto By-law No. 1011-2002.
