BY-LAW No. 585-2003

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form a new public lane south of Queen Street East extending easterly from Berkeley Street.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired through expropriation; and

WHEREAS the date of possession of these expropriated lands is April 22, 2002;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form a new public lane south of Queen Street East extending easterly from Berkeley Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Parts of Lots 32 and 33 on Plan 7A designated as PARTS 1 and 2 on Expropriation Plan 12191 (CA753737), being the same lands illustrated as PARTS 1 and 2 on Plan 64R-16009 in the Land Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
