CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 600-2003

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 150, Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 150-5A.(1) of Chapter 150, Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, City of Toronto Municipal Code, as amended, is further amended by adding the words “If they comply with the conditions in Article VII, issuing” at the beginning thereof, such that the Subsection reads as follows:

§ 150-5A. Authority to issue certificates of parking infraction and parking infraction notices on municipal property; towing and impounding

- (1) If they comply with the conditions in Article VII, issuing certificates of parking infraction and parking infraction notices under Part II of the *Provincial Offences Act* for enforcing by-laws respecting the parking of vehicles on private property and municipal property; and

2. The title of Article VII of Chapter 150, as amended, is further amended by adding the words “; Issuance of Certificates of Parking Infraction and Parking Infraction Notices” such that the title reads “Removal of Vehicles; Issuance of Certificates of Parking Infraction and Parking Infraction Notices”.
3. Subsection 150-13. B(3) of Chapter 150, as amended, is further amended by deleting the word “and” and replacing it with the word “or”.
4. Subsection 150-13. B(4) of Chapter 150, as amended, is further amended by adding the words “tagging or” immediately before the word “towing”.
5. Chapter 150, Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, as amended, is further amended by adding the following section:

§ 150-13.1 Issuance of certificates of parking infraction and parking infraction notices

A municipal law enforcement officer as defined in Article III (private agencies) shall not issue certificates of parking infraction or parking infraction notices except in accordance with the conditions prescribed by sections 150-13.A and B(1) – B(7).

6. This By-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
