BY-LAW No. 638-2003

**To permanently close a portion of Kenaston Gardens, shown as Part 8 on
Reference Plan 66R-20439.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway, Kenaston Gardens, located east of Bayview Avenue and extending southerly from Sheppard Avenue East, shown as Part 8 on Plan 66R-20439 be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to Daniels Kenaston Corporation, upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 10 of the Administration Committee Report No. 4 as adopted by Council at its meeting held on May 21, 22 and 23, 2003; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of the public highway was posted on the Public Notices page of the City's internet web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the North York Community Council meeting held on July 9, 2003 and no one appeared to address the North York Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway, Kenaston Gardens, legally described as follows:

Part of PIN 10090-0313(LT) being that Part of the Public Highway, Kenaston Gardens, shown on Plans 4397 and 8871 North York, described as Blocks A and B and the One Foot Reserve, Plan 4397, and designated as Part 8 on Plan 66R-20439 registered in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Land Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
