BY-LAW No. 685-2003

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes
and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Runnymede Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Runnymede Road	North, adjacent to curb	Bloor Street West and St. Clair Avenue West

B. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Runnymede Road	East, adjacent to curb	Bloor Street West and Ryding Avenue
