CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 689-2003

To amend City of Toronto By-law No. 589-2002 being a By-law to effect Interim Control on lands bounded by Hilldale Road, Cripps Avenue, Spears Street and Hillborn Avenue.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass an Interim Control By-law, for a period of time which shall not exceed one year from the date of passage of the By-law; and

WHEREAS Council on July 30, 2002 passed By-law No. 589-2002 to effect Interim Control on lands bounded by Hilldale Road, Cripps Avenue, Spears Street and Hillborn Avenue in the City for a period of one year from the date of its passing; and

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to extend the period of time during which an Interim Control By-law is to be in effect, provided the total period of time does not exceed two years from the date of the passing of the Interim Control By-law;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Section 3 of the City of Toronto By-law No. 589-2002 be amended by deleting the words "for a period of one year from the date of its passage" and replacing them with the words "until July 29, 2004".
