WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and the owner of the land has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

SECTION 6 AMENDED

1. That Section 6 of Zoning By-law No. 1-83, as amended, of the former City of York, is hereby further amended by adding the following as new Subsection (71)

"(71) MAP 25

By changing the area shown on District Map 25 municipally known as 963 and 1001 Roselawn which lands are pore particularly referenced in Schedule 'A' to this By-law and this Subsection from RM2-16(397) H Zone to RM2-16(397) Zone as shown on Schedule 'A' to this By-law and to Subsection 6(71)".

2. Subject to the provisions of Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, this By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its passing.
