BY-LAW No. 701-2003

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 137, Public Library Board, respecting
the composition of the Toronto Public Library Board.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 137-1 of Chapter 137, Public Library Board, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is deleted and the following substituted therefor:

§ 137-1. Composition; qualifications.

- A. The Library Board shall be composed of 13 members, each of whom shall be appointed by City Council and be qualified to be appointed pursuant to the provisions of the *Public Libraries Act* and such criteria as City Council may establish from time to time.
- B. The membership of the Library Board shall be composed as follows:
 - (1) Five members of City Council, including the Mayor or, if the Mayor is unwilling or unable to act, a member of City Council recommended by the Mayor and approved by Council.
 - (2) Eight individuals who are not members of City Council.

2. This By-law comes into force on December 1, 2003.
