BY-LAW No. 705-2003

Lake Shore Boulevard East and Eastbound Right Anytime the T.T.C. bus loop located approximately 64 metres east of Northern Dancer Boulevard

2. Schedule XIX (Stop Signs) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Lake Shore Boulevard East and the T.T.C. bus
loop located approximately 64 metres east of
Northern Dancer Boulevard

T.T.C. bus loop, northbound, located approximately 64 metres east of Northern Dancer Boulevard
