## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW No. 730-2003**

#### **To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Gerrard Street East and River Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting from the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Gerrard Street East	North, adjacent to curb	A point 30.5 metres east of Church Street to a point 30.5 metres west of Jarvis Street
Gerrard Street East	South, adjacent to curb	Yonge Street to a point 30.5 metres west of Church Street
River Street	West, adjacent to curb	King Street East and a point 50 metres north of Gerrard Street East

- B. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Gerrard Street East	North, adjacent to curb	A point 30.5 metres west of Church Street and a point 30.5 metres west of Jarvis Street

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Gerard Street East	South, adjacent to curb	Yonge Street and a point 30.5 metres east of Church Street
River Street	West, adjacent to curb	King Street East and Gerrard Street East
