Add the following to Part C.9 - Specific Development:

9.247 LANDS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF GRAYDON HALL DRIVE WEST OF DON MILLS ROAD KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS 185 GRAYDON HALL DRIVE.

## Permitted Use:

Notwithstanding the Local Open Space designation a Banquet Hall within the existing Manor Hall and addition shall be permitted.
