BY-LAW No. 810-2003

To amend former City of Scarborough Sign By-law No. 22980, as amended, to delete the words “on the same side of the street”, used when measuring distance separation between billboards, to reduce the minimum distance separation between billboards and to increase the minimum distance of billboards from street intersections.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Scarborough Sign By-law No. 22980, as amended, being “A By-law to prohibit and regulate signs”, is further amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting Sentence 2.4.2 (3)(e) of Schedule “A” and substituting the following Sentence:

“(e) Poster panel, billboards, painted bulletin, posturn and spectacular signs or sign groups shall not be located closer together than 75 metres”.
 - B. By deleting Sentence 2.4.2 (3)(f) of Schedule “A” and substituting the following Sentence:

“(f) No part of a poster panel, billboard, painted bulletin, posturn or spectacular sign or sign group shall be located within 75 metres of an intersection, measured from the point at which two street lines intersect”.
