CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 824-2003

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt the fence on the property municipally known as 93 Erie Street from the maximum height requirements.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing wooden lattice fence ranging in height from approximately 2.87 metres to approximately 3.12 metres, and a wooden board-on-board fence approximately 2.4 metres in height, both of which are located along the north side of the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2003 as 93 Erie Street, may be retained despite the height restriction of 2 metres for such fences in § 447-2B(1).
