BY-LAW No. 836-2003

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on
former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Don Roadway.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Between the north curb line of Lake Shore Boulevard
East and a point 30.5 metres south of the south curb
line of Lake Shore Boulevard East

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:
