CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 854-2003

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Runnymede Road and Unwin Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Runnymede Road	South, adjacent to curb	Bloor Street West and St. Clair Avenue West
Unwin Avenue	South, adjacent to curb	Cherry Street easterly for a distance of approximately 300 metres

B. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Runnymede Road	West, adjacent to curb	Bloor Street West and St. Clair Avenue West
