CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 861-2003

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt a portion of the fence on the property municipally known as 80 Waniska Avenue from the maximum height requirements.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The portion of the existing wooden fence measuring approximately 2.69 metres in height and 5.08 metres in length, located along the west side of the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2003 as 80 Waniska Avenue, along with the wooden lattice fence measuring approximately 2.69 metres in height and 0.86 metres in width, located at the end of the house across the walkway on the west side of the property, may be retained despite the height restriction of 2 metres for such fences in § 447-2B(1).
