CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 889-2003

To define the Blythwood Area as an area of the City of Toronto to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS section 40 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to define one or more areas thereof as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The areas within the heavy lines shown on the maps attached as Schedule "A" are defined as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18, as amended.

ENACTED AND PASSED this 24th day of September, A.D. 2003.

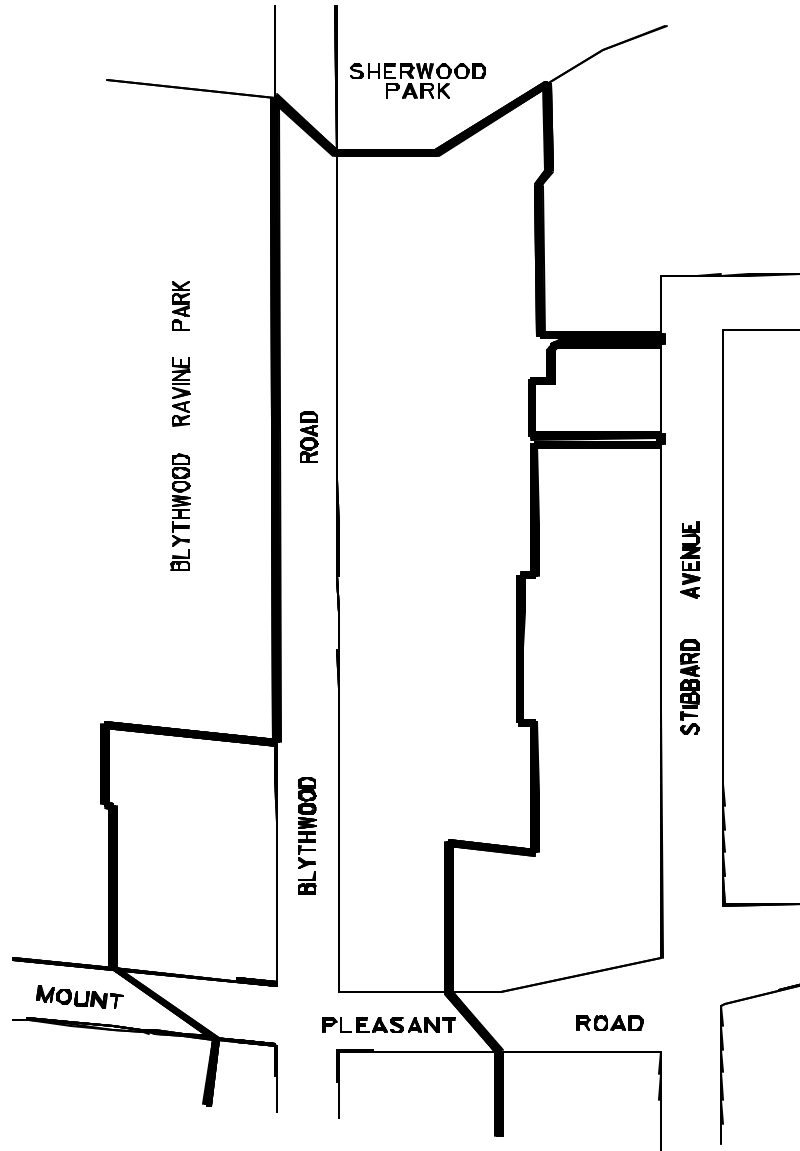
