CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 913-2003

To name the private lane at 2209 Weston Road as “Elphick Lane”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from August 29, 2003 to September 8, 2003, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 9, 2003, and it is appropriate to name the private lane at 2209 Weston Road as “Elphick Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The private lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated July 19, 2003 is named Elphick Lane.
2. Cassidy and Company Architectural Technologists Inc., its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
3. Cassidy and Company Architectural Technologists Inc., its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.


