BY-LAW No. 923-2003

To appoint Dr. Tamara Wallington as Associate Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit and to repeal the appointment of Dr. Rob Stirling as Associate Medical Officer of Health.

WHEREAS the function of appointing Associate Medical Officers of Health is delegated to Council pursuant to the *City of Toronto Act*, 1997 (No.2); and

WHEREAS the *Health Protection and Promotion* Act provides that no one is eligible for appointment as Associate Medical Officer of Health unless the Minister of Health and Long Term Care approves the appointment;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Dr. Tamara Wallington is appointed Associate Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit.
- 2. Section 2 of By-law No. 122-2002 "To appoint Dr. Fran Scott and Dr. Rob Stirling as Associate Medical Officers of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit" is deleted.
- 3. Subject to the approval of the Minister of Health and Long Term Care section 1 of this By-law shall be deemed to have taken effect on September 22, 2002.
- **4.** Section 2 of this By-law comes into force on the day of passage.
