BY-LAW No. 932-2003

To amend former Scarborough Zoning By-law No. 12360, as amended, with respect to the Tam O'Shanter Community.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Sections 34 and 36 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, by the use of the holding symbol "H" in conjunction with any use designation, to specify the use to which lands, buildings or structures may be put at such time in the future as the holding symbol is removed by amendment to the zoning by-law; and whereas the Official Plan of the former City of Scarborough contains provisions relating to the use of holding symbols; and whereas the criteria have been fulfilled such that it is appropriate that the "H" symbol be partially removed;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Exception 9, Section (iii), of **EXCEPTIONS LIST** - Schedule "C" of By-law No. 12360 is hereby amended by replacing the term "31,750 m²" with the term "36,850 m²".
