BY-LAW No. 969-2003

To layout and dedicate certain land extending easterly from Lower Simcoe Street then northerly to Bremner Boulevard, for public highway purposes to be named Grand Trunk Crescent and to assume the municipal services located therein.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land by Instrument No. CA804373, acquired pursuant to a Revised Precinct B Precinct Agreement dated November 29, 1996 and a Precinct B Precinct Agreement dated May 5, 1997, for highway purposes;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land extending easterly from Lower Simcoe Street then northerly to Bremner Boulevard, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66), being composed of:

FIRSTLY: PIN 21395-0097 (LT).

Part of Blocks C, D, and part of Lake Street closed by By-law No. 10950 (4725ES) on Plan 536E and part of Parcel 14 on Plan 153E designated as PARTS 7, 8 and 9 on Plan 64R-14473.

SECONDLY: Part of PIN 21395-0046 (LT).

Part of Block D on Plan 536E designated as PART 4 on Plan 66R-19646 is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes and named Grand Trunk Crescent and the municipal services located therein are assumed.
