BY-LAW No. 979-2003

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 179, Parking Authority, to provide a standing authority to recognize new carparks for enforcement purposes.

WHEREAS it is necessary for enforcement purposes that certain new carparks constructed with the approval of Council be added to Schedule III in Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking; and

WHEREAS Council has approved the establishment of a standing authority to permit the City Solicitor to introduce bills in Council to up-date Schedule III to include references to new carparks acquired, constructed and maintained in accordance with Council approved and the provisions of Chapter 179, Parking Authority;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- A. Municipal Code Chapter 179, Parking Authority, is amended by deleting subsection 179-7E and substituting the following:
 - E. The City Solicitor may process amendments to City by-laws regulating on-street parking meters and parking machines to:
 - (1) Incorporate rates set by the Parking Authority, on certification to the City Solicitor by the President of the Parking Authority that the rates have been set according to the criteria set out in Subsection D;
 - (2) Replace parking meters with parking machines or parking machines with parking meters, on certification to the City Solicitor by the President of the Parking Authority that the replacement has been agreed to by the Ward Councillors for the Ward in which the parking meters or parking machines are located; and
 - (3) Add new carparks to the list in Schedule III of Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, provided that the lands and buildings have been acquired and developed, and approved by Council, in accordance with the requirements of this chapter.
