BY-LAW No. 57-2005

**To layout and dedicate certain land on the south side of Manse Road, east of
Old Kingston Road, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway
Manse Road.**

WHEREAS the owner of 480 Manse Road has requested the City to lift the 0.3 metre reserve that abuts his site on the south side of Manse Road, east of Old Kingston Road to legalize access to Manse Road, which access has been approved as part of a building permit for a single family dwelling on the site;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the south side of Manse Road, east of Old Kingston Road, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 06488-0071 (LT).

PT LT 9, CON 1; PT LT 4, PL 2253; SCARBOROUGH, DESIGNATED AS PART 2 PLAN 66R-21380 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Manse Road.
