BY-LAW No. 73-2005

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 910, Parking Machines, regarding
parking machines on Lombard Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following in alphabetical order from Schedule I:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side Parking)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Hours (Daily As Indicated))	(From Column 5 Fee/Time Limit)	(From Column 6 Maximum Parking)
Lombard Street	Both	Victoria Street and Church Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday	\$3.00 for 1 hour	2 hours
Lombard Street	Both	Victoria Street and Church Street	6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday to Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday	\$3.00 for 1 hour	3 hours

2. Chapter 910, Parking Machines, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following in alphabetical order in Schedule I:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side Parking)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Hours (Daily As Indicated))	(In Column 5 Fee/Time Limit)	(In Column 6 Maximum Parking)
Lombard Street	Both	Victoria Street and a point 68.8 metres west of Church Street	8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday	\$3.00 for 1 hour	2 hours
