BY-LAW No. 105-2005

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to permit the retention of a portion of a wooden pool fence on the property municipally known as 161 Brentcliffe Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing sections of the perimeter wood board pool fence constructed of a repeating pattern of three vertical boards, one 25 millimetre x 152 millimetre board, then two 51 millimetre x 51 millimetre boards, with a bottom rail located 204 millimetres above ground, may be retained for a section of fence 21.25 metres long along the east boundary of the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2005 as 161 Brentcliffe Road, despite the requirement in § 447-3E(2)(b) that vertical wood boards be a minimum of 19 millimetres x 89 millimetres, and the requirement in § 447-3E(1)(c) that no element of the fence that may facilitate climbing can be located between 100 millimetres and 1.2 metres above grade.
