BY-LAW No. 132-2005

**To amend By-law No. 280-2004 to extend the expiration of a part lot control exemption for
445 – 449 Royal York Road from Part Lot Control.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7.4) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 2 of By-law No. 280-2004 is deleted and the following is substituted for it:

This By-law expires two years from the date of its enactment by Council.

2. This By-law applies to the lands described in the attached Schedule “A”.

Legal description:
