BY-LAW No. 188-2005

To amend By-law No. 146-2005, being an amendment to the Official Plan of the Etobicoke Planning Area with respect to the lands located at 60 Bergamot Avenue.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*; and

WHEREAS Council of the City of Toronto enacted an amendment to the Official Plan for the former City of Etobicoke with respect to the lands located at 60 Bergamot Avenue by the passage of By-law No. 146-2005 on February 16, 2005; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 146-2005 contains typographical errors, in that it references the Official Plan Amendment as Amendment No. 122-2005 whereas it should have been referenced as Amendment No. 122-2004;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 146-2005, being an amendment of the Official Plan for the former City of Etobicoke with respect to the lands located at 60 Bergamot Avenue is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "Amendment No. 122-2005" in the heading and in Section 1 thereof, and replacing it with the phrase "Amendment No. 122-2004".
- 2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
