BY-LAW No. 209-2005

To permanently close a portion of the unopened Glengarry Avenue road allowance located at the rear of 250 Lawrence Avenue West.

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the unopened Glengarry Avenue road allowance located at the rear of 250 Lawrence Avenue West be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to Lawrence Park Medical Centre Ltd. upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause 39 of North York Community Council Report 1, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on February 1, 2 and 3, 2005; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the North York Community Council at its meeting held on March 30, 2005;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the unopened Glengarry Avenue road allowance located at the rear of 250 Lawrence Avenue West, described as follows, is hereby permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of PIN 10347-0147 (LT).

Part of Glengarry Avenue on Plan 1537, lying west of Elm Road and east of Plan 64R-11189, City of Toronto, designated as Part 2 on Plan 66R-21637 Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66).
