CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 263-2005

To exempt the lands known municipally as 265-281 and 285-299 David Dunlap Circle from Part Lot Control.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended to pass this By-law; and

WHEREAS on February 16, 2005, Council passed By-law No. 154-2005 exempting all of the lands municipally known as 212-240 David Dunlap Circle and the majority of the lands municipally known as 265-281 and 285-299 David Dunlap Circle from Part Lot Control; and

WHEREAS Schedule "A" to By-law No. 154-2005 did not include all of the proposed lands known as 265-281 and 285-299 David Dunlap Circle within the area approved by Council for Part Lot Control exemption; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 154-2005 was registered on the lands known as 212-240 David Dunlap Circle; and

WHEREAS this By-law exempting the lands known as 265-281 and 285 to 299 David Dunlap Circle from Part Lot Control exemption as previously authorized is required;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the lands described in the attached Schedule "A".
2. This By-law expires two years from the date of its enactment by Council.
