BY-LAW No. 299-2005

To name the proposed private lane at 35 Fieldway Road, being the westerly extension of the public highway Van Dusen Boulevard as “Van Dusen Boulevard”.

WHEREAS the notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from March 14, 2005 to March 29, 2005, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on March 30, 2005, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane at the residential development at 35 Fieldway Road, being the westerly extension of the public highway Van Dusen Boulevard as “Van Dusen Boulevard”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The proposed private lane at 35 Fieldway Road shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated January 12, 2005, is named “Van Dusen Boulevard”.
2. Zanini Developments Inc., its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs for the fabrication and installation of street name signs; and
3. Zanini Developments Inc., its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
