**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 318-2005**

**To amend By-law No. 881-2001, “To appoint a Chief Administrative Officer.” to change  
the title of the official from “Chief Administrative Officer” to “City Manager”.**

WHEREAS under section 229 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the City may appoint a chief administrative officer who shall be responsible for,

- (a) exercising general control and management of the affairs of the municipality for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective operation of the municipality; and
- (b) performing such other duties as are assigned by the municipality; and

WHEREAS the City has appointed an official called the “Chief Administrative Officer” under the predecessor to section 229 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and

WHEREAS Council has approved an administrative reorganization in which the City’s chief administrative officer under section 229 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* is to be called the “City Manager”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 881-2001, “To appoint a Chief Administrative Officer.”, is amended as follows:
  - A. The title of the by-law is deleted and the following substituted:  
  
“To Appoint a Chief Administrative Officer to be called the “City Manager”.
  - B. Section 1 is deleted and the following substituted:
    1. Shirley Hoy is appointed chief administrative officer for the City of Toronto under section 229 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, which office is now called the office of the City Manager, and shall have all the powers conferred and duties imposed upon the City Manager by Article I of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
2. This by-law comes into force on April 15, 2005.
