BY-LAW No. 369-2005

To amend By-law No. 136-2005 being a by-law “To designate the property at 1204 Queen Street West (The Gladstone Hotel) as being of cultural heritage value or interest.”

WHEREAS at its meeting held on February 16, 2005 Council passed By-law No. 136-2005 to designate the property at 1204 Queen Street West (The Gladstone Hotel) as being of cultural heritage value or interest; and

WHEREAS through inadvertence Schedule “B” to By-law No. 136-2005 was not attached to the by-law; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to attach Schedule “B”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 136-2005 is amended by attaching Schedule “B” attached to this by-law.
2. City Solicitor is authorized to cause a copy of By-law No. 136-2005 as amended to be registered against the property described in Schedule “B” to this by-law in the proper Land Registry Office.
3. The City Clerk is authorized to cause a copy of By-law No. 136-2005 as amended to be served upon the owners of the property at 1204 Queen Street West and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of By-law No. 136-2005, as amended to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Toronto as required by the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
