BY-LAW No. 385-2005

**To layout and dedicate certain land on the east side of Royal York Road, south side of
Portland Street, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway
Royal York Road.**

WHEREAS pursuant to City of Toronto By-law No. 483-2000 and Section 41 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with a Site Plan Agreement registered as Instrument No. AT168278 and a Transfer/Deed of Land registered as Instrument No. AT168279 respecting 373 Royal York Road;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the east side of Royal York Road, south side of Portland Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 07617-0719 (LT).

PT LT 190 PL 164 (ETOBICOKE) PT 1 PL 66R-20260 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Etobicoke) and Province of Ontario

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Royal York Road.
